Tahqiq (تحقيق): Verifying; the witnessing of God in the forms of the Divine Names; the verifier is not veiled by God with regard to creation or by creation with regard to God.

Tasawwuf (تصوف): Sufism; Qualification with the Divine Qualities

Talwin (تلوين): Coloration, change; separation after union, culminating in the joining of the theophanies of the Names in the state of subsistence.

Tamas (تمس): Darkness, disorder (compare with *sattva* and *rajas*).

Tanzih (تنزيه): Transcendence.

Tashbih (تشبيه): Immanence.

Tarwassul (توسل): Intercession.

Tawajjuh (توجه): Directed spiritual attention.

Tiba' Tamm (تبع تم): Perfect Nature.

Tifl Falsafi (طفل فلسفي): The Philosophical Child.

'J': hieroglyphic pictogram of hand > yod > jim

Jazba (جذبہ): The attraction of the servant by the power of the Divine lovingkindness, through the stations leading to the Real without difficulty or exertion.

Jars (جرس): The sending of a message with a blow.
