Ba (4): B, the first of possible existences, the second stage of being (Maratib-i ilahi, Divine stages: Ahadiyya, Wahda, Wahdaniyya/Wahidiyya – oneness/absolute, unity/implicit, unicity/explicit)

Jasad (جسد): That part of the soul that takes on a luminous or fiery embodiment.

Jala (جلا): The revelation of the Holy Essence to itself in itself. Istijala استجلا is its revelation to itself in its determinations.

Jalal (جلال) : Power; the veiling of God by God's own glory.

Jamal (جمال): Beauty: the disclosure of God through intimacy.

Jami'at (جمعیت) : Assembly; the drawing together of aspirations to focus on, and serve, God.

Jam' (جمع) : To witness God in the absence of creation.

Jam' al-jam' (جمع الجمع) : To witness God while subsisting in God; separation after union.
